14	The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents a grant from the Centers for Disease
15	Control in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy
16	required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2018.
17	That grant could not have been expected with reasonable certainty when the Ordinance of
18	Estimates for Fiscal Year 2018 was formulated.
19	On April 4, 2018, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City
20	Council.
21	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
22	\$1,059,448 shall be made available to the Health Department – Service 720 (HIV Treatment
23	Services) as a Supplementary Federal Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2018, to
24	provide funding for a demonstration project for HIV/STD prevention programs to help
25	implement a systems-wide organizational trauma-informed approach and cultural shift to support
