

City Council Ordinance #18-0249 was created for the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell all its interest in the property known as 222 West Read Street (Block 0503, Lot 012). This property is no longer needed for public use.

The subject parcel (Block 0503, Lot 012) is an improved parcel of land with a building on it that was previously used to provide public access to cable television management services under the City's cable television franchise agreement with Comcast of Baltimore City, LP. The subject parcel is located in the Mid-Town Belvedere neighborhood in the central area of Baltimore City.

Since this property is no longer needed for public use, and because there is not a significant fiscal impact, the Department of Finance has no objection to the passage of Council Ordinance 18-0249.
