12 13	SECTION 1. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE , That the City Charter is proposed to be amended to read as follows:

15	Article VIII. Franchises
16	§ 1. Authority to grant.
17	The title of the City in and to its waterfront, wharf property, land under water, public
18	landings, wharves and docks, streets, lanes, and parks, AND ITS SEWER SYSTEM AND WATER
19	SUPPLY SYSTEM, AS DESCRIBED IN ARTICLE VII, §§ 33 AND 34 OF THIS CHARTER, is hereby
20	declared to be inalienable.
21	[The] WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE CITY'S SEWER SYSTEM AND WATER-SUPPLY SYSTEM, THE
22	City may grant for a limited time and subject to the limitations and conditions contained in
23	the Charter, specific franchises or rights in or relating to any of the public property or places
24	mentioned in the preceding sentence; provided that such grant is in compliance with the
25	requirements of the Charter, and that the terms and conditions of the grant shall have first
26	been authorized and set forth in an ordinance duly adopted.

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1 2 3 4 5 6	Every such grant shall specifically set forth and define the nature, extent and duration of the franchise or right thereby granted, and no franchise or right shall pass by implication under any such grant; and, notwithstanding any such grant the City shall at all times have and retain the power and right to reasonably regulate in the public interest the exercise of the franchise or right so granted; and the City shall not have the power by grant or ordinance to divest itself of the right or power so to regulate the exercise of such franchise or right.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED , That this proposed amendment to the City Charter be submitted to the legal and qualified voters of Baltimore City, for adoption or rejection, in accordance with Article XI-A, § 5 of the Maryland Constitution, in the form specified by the City Solicitor.
