



The Law Department has reviewed City Council Bill 17-0135 for form and legal sufficiency. The bill would allow the City to condemn and close North Castle Street and 8 alleys of varying widths lying between East Eager Street, North Chester Street, Ashland Avenue, and North Washington Street, as shown on Plat 304-A-7A in the Office of the Department of Transportation. The bill also provides for a special effective date.

Section (34)(a) of Article II of the City Charter grants the Mayor and City Council the power to "construct, open, extend, widen, straighten or close streets, bridges, tunnels or approaches to them and other public ways of every kind within the bounds of the City." Section 116(b)(2) of Article VII of the City Charter requires the Department of Transportation to prepare all ordinances for the opening and closing of streets. As this bill conforms to the applicable sections of the Charter, the Law Department approves it for form and legal sufficiency.

Article I Sections 2, 34, and 35 of the Baltimore City charter establishes a process for disposing of City thoroughfares. The final step in the process is enactment of an Ordinance of the Mayor and City Council.

Background

CC 17-0135 is the companion legislation to CC 17-0134 and is designed to aid development in East Baltimore. The Boundaries are generally: Eager Street on the North, Ashland Avenue on the South, Chester Street on the East and Washington Street on the West.

The subject properties are 9 disconnected parcels containing 8 alleys and a small portion of Castle Street. The total size of the parcels is approximately 4/5th of an acre.

CC 17-0135 condemns and closes the above described parcels. Transfer will be made by separate Ordinance.

If any person wants to remove, alter, or interfere with them, that person must first obtain permission from the Mayor and City Council and, in the application for this permission, must agree to pay all costs and expenses, of every kind, arising out of the removal, alteration, or interference.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That no building or structure of any kind (including but not limited to railroad tracks) may be constructed or erected in or on any part of the street closed under this Ordinance until all subsurface structures and appurtenances owned by

the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore have been abandoned by the Mayor	or and City Council
or, at the expense of the person seeking to erect the building or structure, has	
relaid in accordance with the specifications and under the direction of the Di	rector of

SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That after the closing under this Ordinance, all subsurface structures and appurtenances owned by any person other than the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore shall be removed by and at the expense of their owners, promptly upon notice to do so from the Director of Public Works.

SECTION 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That at all times after the closing under this Ordinance, the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, acting by or through its authorized representatives, shall have access to the subject property and to all subsurface structures and appurtenances used by the Mayor and City Council, for the purpose of inspecting, maintaining, repairing, altering, relocating, or replacing any of them, without need to obtain permission from or pay compensation to the owner of the property.

SECTION 7. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted.



on the west side of the 10-foot alley Southerly 6.6 feet, more or less, to the southernmost extremity of the 10-foot alley; thence binding on the southernmost extremity of the 10-foot alley, if projected westerly, Westerly 11.0 feet, more less, to intersect the east side of the 12-foot alley; and thence binding on the east side of the 12-foot alley Southerly 352.7 feet, more less, to the point of beginning.

Containing 4,383 square feet or 0.101 acres of land, more or less.

Beginning for Parcel No. 9 at the point formed by the intersection of the south side of East Eager Street 66 feet wide, and the west side of North Castle Street 50 feet wide; thence binding on the south side of East Eager Street Easterly 50.0 feet, more or less, to intersect the east side of North Castle Street; thence binding on the east side of North Castle Street Southerly 434.8 feet, more or less, to intersect the north side of Ashland Avenue 66 feet wide; thence binding on the north side of Ashland Avenue Westerly 50.0 feet, more or less, to intersect the west side of North Castle Street; and thence binding on the west side of North Castle Street Northerly 434.8 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.

Containing 21,738 square feet or 0.499 acres of land, more or less.

As delineated on Plat 304-A-7A, prepared by the Survey Section and filed on May 17, 2017, in the Office of the Department of Transportation.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the proceedings for the condemnation and closing of the street and alleys and the rights of all interested parties shall be regulated by and in accordance with all applicable provisions of state and local law and with all applicable rules and regulations adopted by the Director of Transportation and filed with the Department of Legislative Reference.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That after the closing under this Ordinance, all subsurface structures and appurtenances now owned by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore continue to be the property of the Mayor and City Council, in fee simple, until their use has been abandoned by the Mayor and City Council. If any person wants to remove, alter, or interfere with them, that person must first obtain permission from the Mayor and City Council and, in the application for this permission, must agree to pay all costs and expenses, of every kind, arising out of the removal, alteration, or interference.


SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That no building or structure of any kind (including but not limited to railroad tracks) may be constructed or erected in or on any part of the street closed under this Ordinance until all subsurface structures and appurtenances owned by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore have been abandoned by the Mayor and City Council or, at the expense of the person seeking to erect the building or structure, have been removed and relaid in accordance with the specifications and under the direction of the Director of Transportation of Baltimore City.

SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That after the closing under this Ordinance, all subsurface structures and appurtenances owned by any person other than the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore shall be removed by and at the expense of their owners, promptly upon notice to do so from the Director of Public Works.

SECTION 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That at all times after the closing under this Ordinance, the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, acting by or through its authorized representatives, shall have access to the subject property and to all subsurface structures and

appurtenances used by the Mayor and City Council, for the purpose of inspecting, maintaining, repairing, altering, relocating, or replacing any of them, without need to obtain permission from or pay compensation to the owner of the property.

SECTION 7. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted.
