



The Law Department has reviewed City Council Bill 18-0200 for form and legal sufficiency. The purpose of the bill is to change the name of Radecke Park, located at 5602 Radecke Avenue, to Ralph Sears Fields at Radecke Park.

The Baltimore City Code ("BCC") requires that property owned by the Mayor and City Council be named or renamed by ordinance. See BCC, Article 5, § 20-2(a). The bill must be referred for comment to the Planning Commission, the municipal agency that has or will have control of the City property, the Department of Real Estate, and any other agency that may have an interest in the naming the City property. BCC, Article 5, §20-2(b)(1). This bill was referred to the City Solicitor, the Planning Commission, the Department of Real Estate, and the Department of Recreation and Parks. Presumably, the Department of Recreation and Parks is the agency to control this property. Provided that is the case, or that the property will be controlled by one of the other agencies to whom the bill was referred for comment, the Law Department approves the bill for form and legal sufficiency.



SITE/GENERAL AREA

<u>Site Conditions</u>: Radecke Park is a 10 acre public park in northeastern Baltimore. The park located in the Frankford neighborhood, west of Moore's Run Park.

General Area: This Park is in a predominantly residential area. It is surrounded by single family homes with the Garden View Apartments to the southeast and the Gardenvillage Apartments to the south.

HISTORY

There are no previous Planning Commission actions regarding this site.

ANALYSIS

Mr. Ralph Sears was a dedicated, hardworking true volunteer servant to the Radecke Ave Playfield for nearly thirty years. Despite not getting paid or otherwise compensated for the work he did on the field, he was always willing to spend endless hours to ensure that the field, the field house, and bathrooms were kept clean and maintained for the kids and teens using the field for sports activities.

When there was soccer, baseball and football team practice and game days or even meetings, Mr. Sears would show up early mornings or sometimes during the day to pick up trash, empty trash cans, fill field pot holes with dirt from the nearby creek banks, mark and set up the fields for games and even cut some of the grass on both the Radecke Avenue fields and the surrounding areas. He would always ensure that the concession stand had enough supplies.

Most people thought he was a Baltimore City employee because he spent so much time working on and around the fields. Others, thought he had family members associated with the teams until they got to know him and discovered he had no affiliation with the city or the teams that used the park.

Mr. Sears consistently worked to ensure the field and the facilities were ready for the kids, coaches, families and visitors. He was always willing to lend a hand when asked. The people that knew him always said good things about him and what he did to support the activities in the park. For these reasons, staff recommends approval of City Council Bill #18-0200.






