WHEREAS, the U.S. Census Bureau is required by the U.S. Constitution to conduct a count of 9 the population. 10 WHEREAS, the City of Baltimore is committed to ensuring every resident is counted. 11 WHEREAS, federal and state funding is allocated to communities, and decisions are made on 12 matters of national and local importance based, in part, on census data and housing. 13 14 WHEREAS, census data helps determine how many seats each state will have in the U.S. 15 House of Representatives and is necessary for an accurate and fair redistricting of state legislative seats, county and city councils and voting districts. 16 WHEREAS, information from the 2020 Census and American Community Survey are vital 17 tools for economic development and increased employment. 18 WHEREAS, the information collected by the census is confidential and protected by law. 19 20 WHEREAS, a united voice from business, government, community-based and faith-based 21 organizations, educators, media and others will enable the 2020 Census message to reach more of our citizens. 22 23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That Baltimore is committed to partnering with the United States Census Bureau and the State of 24 25 Maryland to support the goals and ideals for the 2020 Census; to disseminate 2020 Census information; to encourage all City residents to participate in events and initiatives that will raise 26 27 the overall awareness of the 2020 Census and increase participation; to provide Census advocates to speak to City and community organizations; to support census takers as they help our City 28
