## AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

3	FOR the purpose of amending the Urban Renewal Plan for Broadway East to reauthorize the		
4	acquisition of properties within the Project Area; waiving certain content and procedural		
5	requirements; making the provisions of this Ordinance severable; providing for the		
6 7	application of this Ordinance in conjunction with certain other ordinances; and providing for a special effective date.

13	Recitals		
14 15	The Urban Renewal Plan for Broadway East was originally approved by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore by Ordinance 88-156 and last amended by Ordinance 14-302.		
16	An amendment to the Urban Renewal Plan for Broadway East is necessary to reauthorize the		
17	Plan's powers of acquisition and condemnation so that these actions may legally continue, in		
18	compliance with § 12-105.1 of the Real Property Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland.		
19	Under Article 13, § 2-6 of the Baltimore City Code, no change may be made in any approved		
20	renewal plan unless the change is approved in the same manner as that required for the approval		
21	of a renewal plan.		
22	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the		
23	following change in the Urban Renewal Plan for Broadway East is approved:		
24	(1) In the Plan, amend C.1 c. to read as follows:

4	c. The authority to acquire Properties within the Project Area is expressly		
5	confirmed and reauthorized through and including [December 31, 2018]		
6	DECEMBER 31, 2022.		
7	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the Urban Renewal Plan for Broadway		
8	East, as amended by this Ordinance and identified as "Urban Renewal Plan, Broadway East,		
9	revised to include Amendment 6, dated May 14, 2018", is approved. The Department of		
10 11	Planning shall file a copy of the amended Urban Renewal Plan with the Department of Legislative Reference as a permanent public record, available for public inspection and		
12	information.		
13	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That if the amended Urban Renewal Plan		
14	approved by this Ordinance in any way fails to meet the statutory requirements for the content of		
15	a renewal plan or for the procedures for the preparation, adoption, and approval of a renewal		
16 17	plan, those requirements are waived and the amended Urban Renewal Plan approved by this Ordinance is exempted from them.

18	SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That if any provision of this Ordinance or the		
19	application of this Ordinance to any person or circumstance is held invalid for any reason, the		
20	invalidity does not affect any other provision or any other application of this Ordinance, and for		
21	this purpose the provisions of this Ordinance are declared severable.		
22	SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That if a provision of this Ordinance concerns		
23	the same subject as a provision of any zoning, building, electrical, plumbing, health, fire, or		
24	safety law or regulation, the applicable provisions shall be construed to give effect to each.		
25	However, if the provisions are found to be in irreconcilable conflict, the one that establishes the		
26	higher standard for the protection of the public health and safety prevails. If a provision of this		
27 28	Ordinance is found to be in conflict with an existing provision of any other law or regulation that		
29	establishes a lower standard for the protection of the public health and safety, the provision of this Ordinance prevails and the other conflicting provision is repealed to the extent of the		
30	conflict.
