The Department of Finance has reviewed City Council Bill #18-0302, for the purpose of deleting an exception for the sale of motor vehicle fuels; authorizing the issuance of a conditional license for certain delivery services; and generally related to the licensing of late-night commercial operations.

If enacted, this bill will revise Article 15 of the Baltimore City Code to remove an exemption for the sale of motor vehicle fuel. It will also grant the Finance Department the authority to issue a late-night operations license for a business to operate a late-night delivery-only service, conditioned upon all indoor sales and dining areas being closed to the public during late-night hours. The Department of Finance does not anticipate a material fiscal impact after the passage of this legislation.

The Department of Finance supports the passage of this bill conditioned upon the amendments discussed with the bill's sponsor.
