

City Council Bill #18-0309 is being introduced for the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell, at either public or private sale, all its interest in a certain property known as 732 West Lexington Street (Block 0586, Lot 002) and no longer needed for public use; and providing for a special effective date.

The parcel, containing 63,641 square feet (0.323 acres), is an unimproved parcel of land located in Poppleton Urban Renewal Area. The property is no longer needed for public use. There is no anticipated fiscal impact.

The Department of Finance has no objection to the passage of Council Bill 18-0309.
