## AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

3	FOR the purpose of condemning and closing a portion of South Washington Street, extending		
4	from Aliceanna Street southerly 90 feet to the southernmost extremity of it, as shown on Plat		
5	344-A-60A in the Office of the Department of Transportation; and providing for a special

15	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the		
16	Department of Transportation shall proceed to condemn and close a portion of South Washington		
17	Street, extending from Aliceanna Street southerly 90 feet to the southernmost extremity of it, and		
18	more particularly described as follows:		
19	Beginning for Parcel No. 1 at the point formed by the intersection of the west side		
20	of South Washington Street 70 feet wide, and the south side of Aliceanna Street		
21	70 feet wide, the point of beginning being distant Easterly 300.0 feet, more or		
22	less, measured along the south side of Aliceanna Street from the point formed by		
23	the intersection of the south side of Aliceanna Street and the east side of South		
24	Wolfe Street 60 feet wide; thence crossing South Washington Street Easterly 70.0		
25	feet to intersect the east side of South Washington Street; thence departing from		
26	the south side of Aliceanna Street and binding on the east side of South		
27	Washington Street Southerly 90.0 feet, more or less, to the southernmost		
28	extremity of it; thence binding on the southernmost extremity of South

5 6	As delineated on Plat 344-A-60A, prepared by the Survey Section and filed on April 20, 2018, in the Office of the Department of Transportation.
7 8 9 10 11	<b>SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED</b> , That the proceedings for the condemnation and closing of a portion of Aliceana Street and the rights of all interested parties shall be regulated by and in accordance with all applicable provisions of state and local law and with all applicable rules and regulations adopted by the Director of Transportation and filed with the Department of Legislative Reference.
12 13 14 15 16 17 18	<b>SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED</b> , That after the closing under this Ordinance, all subsurface structures and appurtenances now owned by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore continue to be the property of the Mayor and City Council, in fee simple, until their use has been abandoned by the Mayor and City Council. If any person wants to remove, alter, or interfere with them, that person must first obtain permission from the Mayor and City Council and, in the application for this permission, must agree to pay all costs and expenses, of every kind, arising out of the removal, alteration, or interference.

AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED</b> , That no building or structure of any kind (including but not limited to railroad tracks) may be constructed or erected in or on any part of the street closed under this Ordinance until all subsurface structures and appurtenances owned by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore have been abandoned by the Mayor and City Council or, at the expense of the person seeking to erect the building or structure, have been removed and relaid in accordance with the specifications and under the direction of the Director of Transportation of Baltimore City.

AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED</b> , That after the closing under this Ordinance, all subsurface structures and appurtenances owned by any person other than the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore shall be removed by and at the expense of their owners, promptly upon notice to do so from the Director of Public Works.
30 31 32 33 34 35	<b>SECTION 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED</b> , That at all times after the closing under this Ordinance, the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, acting by or through its authorized representatives, shall have access to the subject property and to all subsurface structures and appurtenances used by the Mayor and City Council, for the purpose of inspecting, maintaining, repairing, altering, relocating, or replacing any of them, without need to obtain permission from or pay compensation to the owner of the property.
36 37	<b>SECTION 7. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED</b> , That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted.
