**TO:** Council President Young and Members of the City Council

The Department of Human Resources (“DHR”) reviewed the above captioned City Council Bill. This legislation seeks to measure the compliance of City Officials with residency and voting registration requirements and to determine how to move forward so that 100% compliance is reached. DHR supports Council Bill 18-0110R.

As of Monday, February 4, 2019, DHR Policy and Compliance Division has completed two separate reviews of the City’s compliance with Council Bill 18-0110R. To date, no employee covered by the legislation is out of compliance.
