11	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That, in		
12	accordance with Article II, § 15(c) of the City Charter, the Commissioner of Housing and		
13	Community Development may sell, at either public or private sale, all the interest of the Mayor		
14	and City Council of Baltimore in the property known as 732 West Lexington Street (Block 0586,		
15	Lot 002), and more particularly described as follows:		
16	The subject parcel (Block 0586, Lot 002) is an unimproved parcel of land located		
17	in the Poppleton Urban Renewal Area, consisting of approximately 63,641 square		
18	feet, more or less.		
19	This property being no longer needed for public use.		
20	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That no deed may pass under this Ordinance		
21	unless the deed has been approved by the City Solicitor.		
22	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it i
