INTRODUCTION – City Property - Naming the Baseball Diamond, located in the Southeast Portion of Swann Park, 300 West McComas Street, the Al Kaline Field.

PURPOSE/PLANS – For the purpose of naming the baseball diamond, located in the southeast portion of Swann Park, 300 West McComas Street, the Al Kaline Field.

COMMENTS – The purpose of this bill is to rename the baseball field located within South Baltimore’s Swann Park after Baltimorean, former Detroit Tiger, and Major League Baseball Hall of Famer – Al Kaline. Al Kaline attended the old Southern High School, which has since been renamed Digital Harbor High School.
