<u>INTRODUCTION</u> – AN ORDINANCE concerning Building, Fire, and Related Codes – Drainage.

<u>PURPOSE/PLANS</u> – FOR the purpose of amending the City Building Code and the City Residential Code to provide for additional limitations on drainage; and clarifying and conforming related provisions.

<u>COMMENTS</u> – City Council Bill 19-0339 seeks to solve the problem of ice forming on the roadway due to a continuous water source combined with a spell of cold weather. This is an issue at select sites around the city.

The responsibility, criteria and remedy are less clear, however. The bill states that the flow is prohibited when there is a "reasonable likelihood that the discharge will freeze."

<u>AGENCY/DEPARTMENT POSITION</u> – The Department of Transportation defers to the Department of Public Works.
