INTRODUCTION – Commercial Parking Facilities - Revisions

<u>PURPOSE/PLANS</u> — For the purpose of making certain revisions to the City's ordinances regarding parking facilities; clarifying the application of the subtitle as it relates to commercial parking facilities; requiring that commercial parking facilities provide customers with proof-of-payment; prohibiting certain commercial parking facilities from removing motor vehicles without the owner's consent; increasing certain fines; conforming and clarifying related provisions; and generally related to the regulation of commercial parking facilities.

<u>COMMENTS</u> – The Department of Transportation's Towing Division expects this bill to result in a reduction of trespass tow complaints. Requiring proof-of-payment at all commercial parking facilities will likely reduce instances of tow companies wrongfully towing vehicles of owners who paid to park, but were not provided a receipt. This legislation is not expected to have an operational or fiscal impact on the Department of Transportation.

<u>AGENCY/DEPARTMENT POSITION</u> – The Department of Transportation supports City Council bill 19-0366.


