He made a difference in the lives of others, especially in the East Baltimore community.



REQUEST: City Council Bill #18-0310/ City Property – Renaming the Oliver Pool to the John D. Murdock Pool

For the purpose of changing the name of the Oliver Pool, located at 1641 North Spring Street, to the John D. Murdock Pool.

RECOMMENDATION: Amend and Approve

- On page 1 lines 4 and line 19 strike address 1641 North Spring Street and replace with 1301 East Lanvale Street.

OWNER: Mayor and City Council

SITE/GENERAL AREA

Site Conditions: The subject property is on the Northeast corner of Harford Avenue and East Lanvale Street. The Oliver Recreation Center sits on a lot adjacent to the pool.

General Area: The area is predominantly residential with some commercial and institutional buildings. The property is located within the Oliver Urban Renewal Plan area.

HISTORY

- The Oliver Urban Renewal Plan (URP) was established by Ord. #71-1067, dated May 17, 1971.
- Amendment No. 12, dated December 5, 2002, was approved by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City by Ord. #02-458, dated December 19, 2002.
- Amendment No. 13, dated January 31, 2001, was approved by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City by Ord. #11-449, dated May 26, 2011.

ANALYSIS

Background: John Murdock was born and raised in East Baltimore on the 1600 block of East Madison Street. He graduated from the University of Baltimore in 1978 with his bachelor's degree in recreational administration. Before working for the city, Mr. Murdock played for and coached the East Side Chargers football team. One of his goals before he passed was to become a criminal defense lawyer. Over the years, he took classes in law so he could help troubled youth.

Many people knew and referred to John Murdock as "Coach." He had deep ties to the community as a youth basketball coach and mentor. Mr. Murdock's greatest mentors were the teachers who pushed him to pursue his dream of helping youth. He coached basketball for over half a century at various recreation centers and leagues across Baltimore. He was a staple at the Oliver Recreation Center and Eastern Community Action Partnership Center was his second home. Along with basketball, Mr. Murdock coached youth baseball, soccer and track. While sports were everything to Mr. Murdock, he stressed the importance of education to all of the children he encountered. School came first and he worked with youth on their studies and connected them to academic resources.

Notification: The Oliver Community Association, Oliver Action Team, Meraki Community Uplift, Out4Justice, New Broadway East Community Association and Councilman Robert Stokes Sr. have been notified of this action.

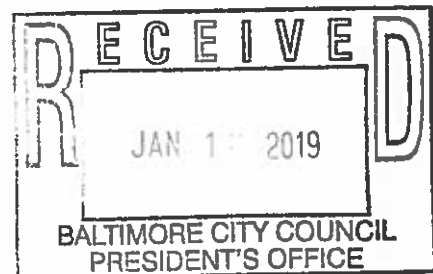

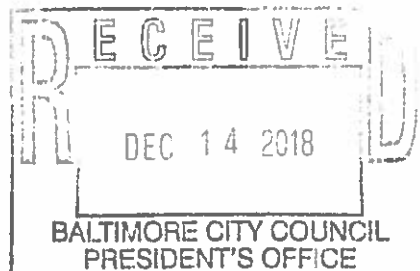

ANALYSIS

Current Law

Baltimore City Code Article 5, § 20-2(a) authorizes the renaming of city-owned property by ordinance of the Mayor and City Council.

Background

John Murdock (1945-2018) was born and raised in East Baltimore on the 1600 block of East Madison Street. He graduated from the University of Baltimore in 1978 with his bachelor's degree in recreational administration. Many people knew and referred to John Murdock as "Coach." He coached basketball for over half a century at various recreation centers and leagues across Baltimore, and he was a staple at the Oliver Recreation Center. Along with basketball, Mr. Murdock coached youth baseball, soccer, and track. Mr. Murdock also stressed the importance of education to all of the children he encountered, and he worked with youth on their studies and connected them to academic resources.

The Oliver Pool is located in the Oliver neighborhood of East Baltimore, adjacent to the Oliver Recreation Center. The bill states the pool's street address as 1641 North Spring Street. However, the Planning Commission determined that 1301 East Lanvale Street is the correct address, and recommended an amendment to the bill accordingly.

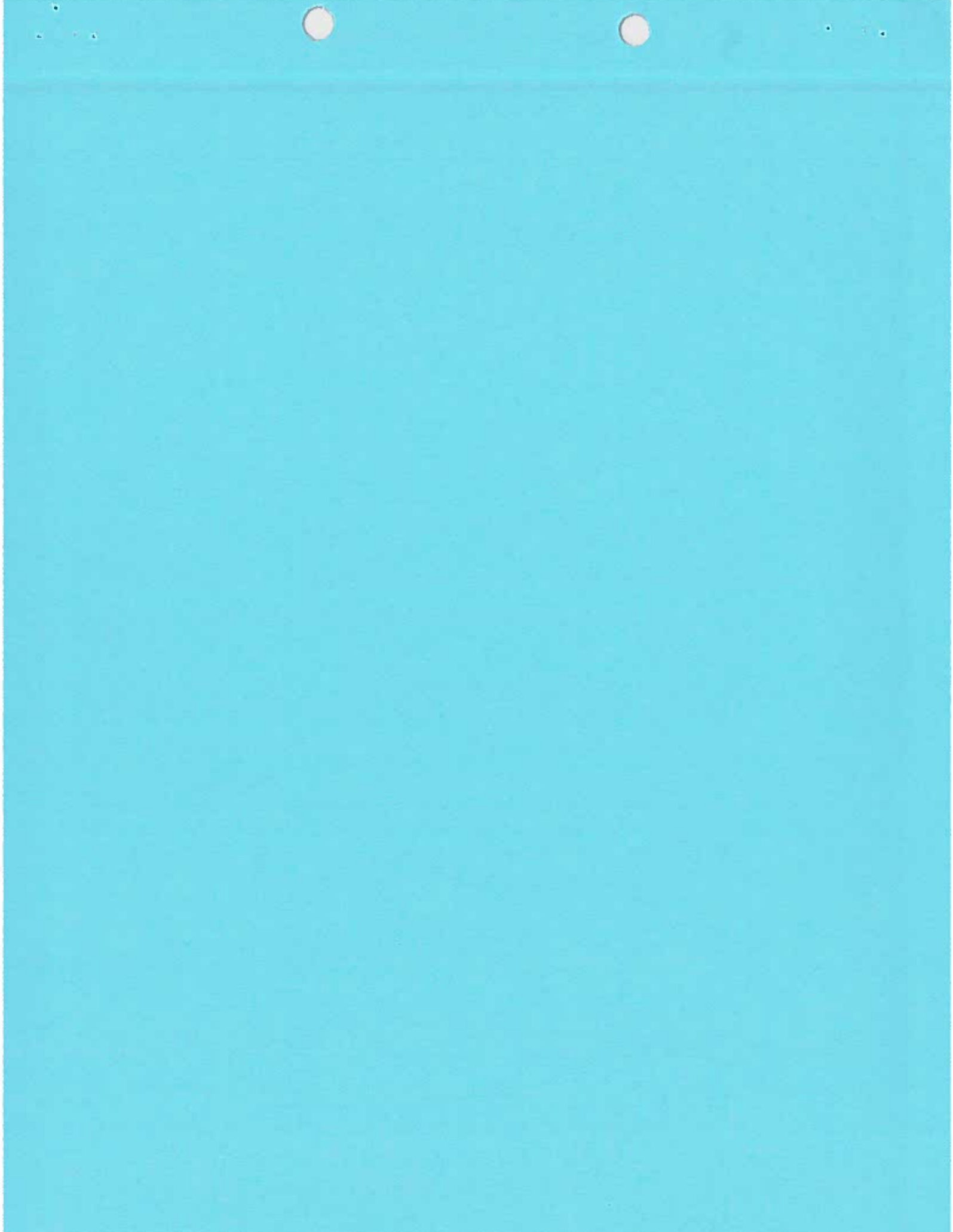
