Recitals

The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents funds from Income Tax in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2019.

This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of
 Estimates for Fiscal Year 2019 was formulated.

19 This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the 20 Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2019 was formulated or is for a new program that could 21 not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the \$1,500,000 shall be made available to the Department of Public Works – Service 663 (Waste Removal and Recycling) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2019, to provide funding for additional operating expenses. The source of revenue for this appropriation is funds from Income Tax in excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2019.
