City Council Bill #19-0343 has been introduced for the purpose of extending the City's Minority and Women's Business Enterprise program by another year. Section 28-5 of Article 5 of the City Code would be amended to reflect an expiration date of August 31, 2020.

Back Ground

Housed in the Law Department, the Minority and Women's Business Opportunity Office (MWBOO) is responsible for certification of Minority Business Enterprises (MBEs) and Women Business Enterprises (WBEs), maintaining a directory of certified businesses, investigating alleged violations of the MWBE ordinance, maintaining statistics on availability and utilization of MBEs and WBEs, setting annual participation goals, setting contract participation goals on a contract by contract basis, setting participation goals on City-assisted projects, and providing assistance to bidders and developers in identifying MBE/WBE firms.

Impact/ Analysis

In the City budget, MWBOO is a service within the Law Department. The Fiscal 2019 General Fund appropriation is \$747,855. This bill has no fiscal impact.

Conclusion

The Department of Finance has no objection to the passage of Council Bill 19-0343.
