AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

Rezoning – 1818 East Pratt Street

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2 FOR the purpose of changing the zoning for the property known as 1818 East Pratt Street (Block
3 1745, Lot 026), as outlined in red on the accompanying plat, from the R-8 Zoning District to
4 the C-1 Zoning District.

11 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That
12 Sheet 57 of the Zoning District Map is amended by changing from the R-8 Zoning District to the
13 C-1 Zoning District the property known as 1818 East Pratt Street (Block 1745, Lot 026), as
14 outlined in red on the plat accompanying this Ordinance.

15 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That as evidence of the authenticity of the
16 accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning
17 Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council
18 shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat;

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1 and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the
2 Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals, the Planning Commission, the Commissioner of
3 Housing and Community Development, the Supervisor of Assessments for Baltimore City, and
4 the Zoning Administrator.

5 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day
6 after the date it is enacted.
