SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That, in accordance with Article V, § 5(b) of the City Charter, the City Comptroller may sell, at either public or private sale, all the interest of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore in the air rights over a portion of the public right of way of the 4100 Block of Hillen Road, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning for the same at a point on the west side of Hillen Road, 120 feet wide the point of beginning being distant Northerly 596.6 feet, more or less, from a point formed by the intersection of the west side of Hillen Road and the north side of Argonne Drive 80 feet wide, the point also being in a horizontal plane 14.75 feet above street level at its lowest point; thence binding on the west side of Hillen Road North 16 degrees 24 minutes 40 seconds East 19.80 feet to a point on the north side of the air rights over a portion of the public right of way of the 4100 Block of Hillen Road; thence crossing Hillen Road North 81 degrees 49 minutes
