16	2019.		
17	This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of		
18	Estimates for Fiscal Year 2019 was formulated.		
19	This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the		
20	Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2019 was formulated or is for a new program that could		
21	not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the \$10,000,000 shall be made available to the Department of Transportation – Service 683 (Street Management) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2019, to provide funding for additional operating expenses. The source of revenue for this appropriation is funds from Recordation Tax Revenue (\$8,500,000) and from Transfer Tax Revenue (\$1,500,000) in excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2019.
