I am herein reporting on City Council Bill 18-0291 introduced by Councilmember Costello.

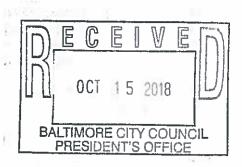
The purpose of this bill is for permitting, subject to certain conditions, the construction and maintenance of a portion of a building projecting into the public right-of-way on the west side of the property known as 524 North Charles Street.

According to Baltimore City Building, Fire, and Related Codes § 3201.3.1.1, no person may use, encroach on, or connect to any street, highway, alley, or other public right-of-way for any purpose unless that person first obtains permission to do so by an ordinance of the Mayor and City Council. This proposed legislation requests an encroachment of no more than 3 feet into the public right-of-way of Morton Street.

The Parking Authority of Baltimore City (PABC) reviewed the proposed legislation. Onstreet parking is not permitted on either side of Morton Street. Therefore, PABC does not administer on-street parking programs on this block. A site visit was conducted during the last week of September 2018, and PABC has determined that the passage of this bill will not negatively impact parking in the area.

Based on the comments above, PABC does not oppose the passage of City Council Bill 18-0291.

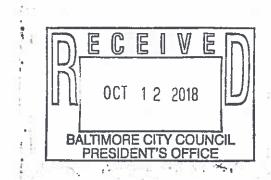

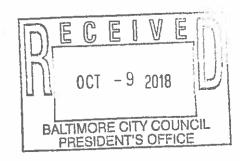

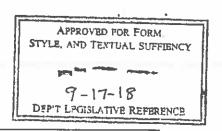
