- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
- 12 Sheet 58 of the Zoning District Map is amended by changing from the R-8 Zoning District to the
- 13 C-1 Zoning District the property known as 3515 East Lombard Street (Block 6288, Lot 034), as
- 14 outlined in red on the plat accompanying this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED. That as evidence of the authenticity of the 15 accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning 16 Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council 17 shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat; 18 19 and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals, the Planning Commission, the Commissioner of 20 Housing and Community Development, the Supervisor of Assessments for Baltimore City, and 21 22 the Zoning Administrator.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day
 after the date it is enacted.
