INTRODUCTION – City Streets - Opening - Air Rights over a Portion of the Public Right of Way of the 200 Block of North Broadway

PURPOSE/PLANS – For the purpose of condemning and opening the air rights area over a portion of the public right of way of the 200 block of North Broadway, as shown on Plat 306-A-23 in the Office of the Department of Transportation; and providing for a special effective date.

COMMENTS – Council Bill 19-0433 is specifically tied to the recently completed Skip Viragh Cancer Center located at Johns Hopkins' East Baltimore Campus. Council Bill 19-0433 is a companion bill to Council Bills 19-0434 and 19-0435, collectively allowing for the opening, closing and sale of air rights over a portion of public right-of-way on the 200 block of North Broadway Street.


The opening, closing and sale of air rights allows for an approximately roughly 10.5 foot bump-out on the upper levels floors of the Skip Viragh Cancer Center that extends over the sidewalk running along the eastern side of the 200 block of North Broadway Street. In total, the bump out contains roughly 1,830 square feet of air space.

The Department of Transportation does not foresee any fiscal or operational impacts associated with the passage of Council Bill 19-0433.
