INTRODUCTION – Rezoning - Block 7762, Lots 001-007

<u>PURPOSE/PLANS</u> – For the purpose of changing the zoning for the properties known as Block 7762, Lots 001-007, as outlined in red on the accompanying plat, from the R-3 Zoning District to the R-6 Zoning District.

<u>COMMENTS</u> – Council Bill 19-0463 seeks to rezone Block 7762, Lots 001-007, located at the intersection of Letitia Avenue and Kerkimer Street from the R-3 Zoning District to the R-6 Zoning District. R-3 Zoning Districts permit single family homes while R-6 Zoning Districts more towards traditional rowhomes or newer townhomes. The bill's statement of intent indicates that the property owner intends to build several single-family homes on the parcel.

The Department of Transportation does not foresee any significant fiscal or operational impacts associated with the passage of Council Bill 19-0463.
