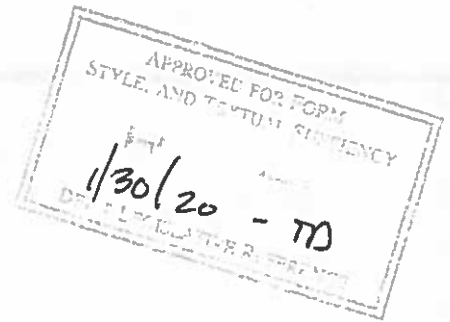


AMENDMENTS TO COUNCIL BILL 18-0285
(1st Reader Copy)

Amendment No. 1 {Title, Purpose Clause, and Function}

On page 1, in line 2, strike “Police Ordinances –”; and, on that same page and line, strike “Playing in the Street” and substitute “**Fun**”; and, on that same page, in line 4, after the semi-colon, insert “repealing the prohibition on bicycle coasting and trick riding;”; and, on that same page, after line 10, insert:

“BY repealing
Article 31 - Transit and Traffic
Section 18-6
Baltimore City Code
(Edition 2000)”;

and, on that same page, in line 13, strike “41-4(2)(§ 50-41)” and substitute “41-14(2)(§ 50-41)”.

Amendment No. 2 {Substantive Repeal of Art. 31, § 18-6}

On page 2, after line 11, insert:

“Article 31. Transit and Traffic

Subtitle 18. Bicycles

[§ 18-6. Coasting; trick riding.]

[It is unlawful for any person riding a bicycle on any of the streets, lanes, alleys, or public ways of this City:

- (1) to coast by inertia or momentum without having both feet on the pedals;**
- (2) to ride without at least 1 hand firmly gripping the handlebars;**
- (3) to perform any trick or fancy riding; or**
- (4) to ride in any manner so as not to have the bicycle under control.]”.**
