20	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That			
21	\$37,600 shall be made available to the Sheriff – Service 882 (Deputy Sheriff Enforcement) as a			
22	Supplementary General State Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2020, to provide			
23	funding to improve the recruitment and retention of the Sheriff's court security officers. The			
24	source of revenue for this appropriation is the grant from the Maryland Governor's Office of
