 - o Concern/Comments: Students with IAP's
 - 1. Help getting resources/computers
 - 2. Help getting the services needed
 - o Comment: The importance of de-escalating situations when needed
 - o The Elijah Cummings Act Trauma Act
 - 1. Currently working on the MOU (Memorandum of Understanding)
 - 2. Hope that the Commission will serve as a bridge to help people who experience trauma; that bridge between city government and the Commission.
