BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That, in accordance with Article V, § 5(b) of the City Charter, the City Comptroller may sell, at either public or private sale, all the interest of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore in the property known as 5001 Reisterstown Road aka Langston Hughes Elementary School (Block 4596, Lot 001), and more particularly described as follows:
17 18	The subject parcel is a former Baltimore city public school property known as Langston Hughes Elementary School, which has been surplussed,
19 20	containing approximately 2.074 acres, more or less, this property being no longer needed for public use.
21 22	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That no deed may pass under this Ordinance unless the deed has been approved by the City Solicitor.
23 24	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted.
