- 1. Councilman Cohen, primary sponsor of the bill gave opening remarks. Some highlights of same were:
 - Explained what the bill does
 - The bill is a corrective measure for the original task force
 - Teachers are truly on the front line when dealing with trauma; our teachers will be dealing with a lot of stress and abuse associated with students and their voices should be heard
- 2. Several representatives from city agencies were in attendance to talk about his/her agency reports. None of the agencies reporting were in opposition to the bill.
- 3. Representatives from the Law Department and the Baltimore City Public Schools talked about their proposed amendments.
- 4. Councilman Cohen asked the Law Department's representative to clarify if the BCPS proposed amendment could be implemented. Answer: Yes, this amendment can be done if the committee/council choses to do so. Per Councilman Cohen, "I would like for the School's CEO and Teachers' Union to have some input."
- 5. Committee members voted on the proposed amendments submitted by the Law Department.
- 6. A floor amendment may be forthcoming. Vote taken.
- 7. Hearing concluded.
