Re: City Council Bill 20-0555 – High-Performance Market-Rate Rental Housing Tax Credit – Revision

Dear President and City Council Members:

The Law Department has reviewed City Council Bill 20-0555 for form and legal sufficiency. The bill would amend the existing Tax Credit for High-Performance Market-Rate Rental Housing—Citywide in Section 10-18 of Article 28 (Taxes) of the City Code. The bill would remove tax-increment financing from Subsection (h) of Section 10-18 concerning tax credit duplication to allow a property to receive this credit even if it also receives tax-increment financing.

The General Assembly has given the City the authority to enact this tax credit. Md. Code, Tax-Prop., § 9-242. This includes the authority to create criteria and qualifications for the credit. Md. Code, Tax-Prop., § 9-242(c). The change proposed in this bill is consistent with this state enabling legislation. The Law Department approves this bill for form and legal sufficiency.
