INTRODUCTION – Approval for the Exchange of a Class B-D-7 License to a Class A-7 License - 1041 Greenmount Avenue

PURPOSE/PLANS – For the purpose of providing the required approval under Md. Code Ann., Alc. Bev. § 12-902.1(d)(1) to allow the license holder holding a valid Class B-D-7 Beer, Wine, and Liquor License issued for 1041 Greenmount Avenue, Baltimore, Maryland 21202 to apply to the Board of Liquor License Commissioners for Baltimore City to exchange their Class B-D-7 Beer, Wine, and Liquor License for a Class A-7 Beer, Wine, and Liquor License.

COMMENTS – During the 2018 Legislative Session, the Maryland General Assembly passed Senate Bill 519, allowing existing B-D-7 license holders to exchange their existing license for an A-7 license, contingent on a supportive resolution advancing through the Baltimore City Council. Council Resolution 20-0235R is the legislation necessary to allow for the exchange of the existing B-D-7 license, presently located at 1041 Greenmount Avenue, for an A-7 license that will be utilized at the same location.

AGENCY/DEPARTMENT POSITION – The Department of Transportation currently foresees no fiscal nor operational impact resulting from the advancement of Council Resolution 20-0235R. The Department of Transportation has **no objection** to City Council Resolution 20-0235R.
