AN ORDINANCE concerning 1 2 City Streets - Opening -A 13-Foot Alley 3 4 FOR the purpose of condemning and opening a 13-foot alley, extending from East Biddle Street 5 Northerly 80 feet, to a 20-foot alley laid out in the rear of the properties known as nos. 2000 through 2030 East Biddle Street, as shown on Plat 314-B-16 in the Office of the Department 6 of Transportation; and providing for a special effective date. 7 By authority of 8 Article I - General Provisions 9 10 Section 4 11 and Article II - General Powers 12 13 Sections 2, 34, and 35 **Baltimore City Charter** 14 15 (1996 Edition) 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the Department of Transportation shall proceed to condemn and open a 13-foot alley, extending from 17 East Biddle Street Northerly 80 feet, to a 20-foot alley laid out in the rear of the properties known 18 19 as nos. 2000 through 2030 East Biddle Street, and more particularly described as follows: 20 Beginning for Parcel 1 at the point formed by the intersection of the east side of a 13-foot alley and the north side of East Biddle Street 66 feet wide, the point of 21 beginning being distant 194 feet measured along the north side of East Biddle 22 Street from the intersection of North Chester Street 60 feet wide, and the north 23 side of East Biddle Street; thence binding on the north side of East Biddle Street 24 25 Westerly 13 feet to the west side of a 13-foot alley; thence binding on the west 26 side of the 13-foot alley Northerly 80 feet to intersect the south side of a 20-foot 27 alley; thence binding on the south side of the 20-foot alley Easterly 21.9 feet, more or less, to the easternmost extremity of the 20 foot-alley; thence leaving the 28
