9 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the  
10 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

11 **Baltimore City Code**

12 **Article 5. Finance, Property, and Procurement**

13 **Subtitle 34. Commission on Sustainability**

14 **§ 34-2. Terms; Chair OR CO-CHAIRS.**

15 . . .  
16 (b) *Commission Chair OR CO-CHAIRS.*

17 The Mayor shall appoint one member as Chair of the Commission OR MAY APPOINT TWO  
18 MEMBERS AS CO-CHAIRS OF THE COMMISSION.

19 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance  
20 are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior  
21 Ordinance.

22 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day  
23 after the date it is enacted.
