11 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the
12 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

16 **Subtitle 4. Registration of Non-Owner-Occupied Dwellings,**

18 **§ 4-1. Definitions.**

19 (f) *Person.*

20 (1) *In general.*

21 “Person” means:

22 (i) an individual;

23 (ii) a partnership, firm, association, corporation, or other entity of any kind; [and]
24 OR

25 (iii) a receiver, trustee, guardian, personal representative, fiduciary, or
26 representative of any kind.

27 (2) *Inclusions.*

28 “Person” includes, except as used in [§ 4-13] § 4-15 {“Penalties”} of this subtitle, a
29 governmental entity or an instrumentality or unit of a governmental entity.

1 (i) *Vacant structure.*

2 (1) *In general.*

3 “Vacant structure” means any structure that is subject to an unabated violation notice
4 issued under § 116 {“Unsafe Structures”} of the Baltimore City Building Code.

5 (2) *Exclusions.*

6 “Vacant structure” does not include an accessory structure that is not intended for
7 occupancy, such as a garage, shed, or storage building.

8 § 4-6. Registration statement – Contents.

9 (a) *In general.*

10 Each registration statement must be in the form that the Commissioner requires and
11 contain the following information:

12 (1) a description of the premises by street number or by block-and-lot;

13 (2) the name, street address, telephone number, and email address of the premises’
14 owner of record;

15 (3) the name, street address, telephone number, and email address of the premises’
16 managing operator, if other than the owner; and

17 (4) if the owner is a corporation, partnership, limited partnership, limited liability
18 company, or similar entity, the name, street address, telephone number, and email
19 address of a natural person who serves as the owner’s chief executive officer,
20 managing partner, or managing member, or in a similarly authoritative position.

21 (b) *Change of listed information.*

22 The Commissioner must be notified within 10 days of any change in the identity of or
23 contact information for the owner of record or any other person listed in the registration
24 statement.

4 (1) THE INFORMATION SET FORTH IN § 4-6(A) {"REGISTRATION STATEMENT –
5 CONTENTS: IN GENERAL"} OF THIS SUBTITLE; OR

11 THE SIGN REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION MUST BE POSTED WITHIN 10
12 DAYS OF REGISTERING THE VACANT STRUCTURE WITH THE COMMISSIONER UNDER
13 § 4-5 {"REGISTRATION REQUIRED"} OF THIS SUBTITLE.

15 ~~IF THE OWNER OF A VACANT STRUCTURE AMENDS A REGISTRATION UNDER § 4-6(B)~~
16 ~~{"REGISTRATION STATEMENT – CONTENTS: CHANGE OF LISTED INFORMATION"} OF~~
17 ~~THIS SUBTITLE, THE OWNER MUST MAKE ANY COMMENSURATE SIGN CHANGES WITHIN~~

19 (C) *VACANT STRUCTURES IN DEFAULT OR FORECLOSURE.*

20 IN ADDITION TO THE REQUIREMENTS SET FORTH IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, IF
21 THE PROPERTY IS IN DEFAULT OR IN FORECLOSURE, THE SIGN REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION
22 MUST ALSO INCLUDE THE NAME, ADDRESS, AND TELEPHONE NUMBER OF ANY CREDITORS
23 OR LIEN HOLDERS.

24 (D) *SIGN SPECIFICATIONS.*

25 A SIGN REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION MUST BE:

26 (1) IMPERVIOUS TO WEATHER CONDITIONS;

27 (2) LEGIBLY WRITTEN IN A FONT SIZE OF NOT LESS THAN 18 POINTS; AND

28 (3) NO SMALLER THAN 8 ½ INCHES BY 11 INCHES IN SIZE.

6 (1) THE NUMBER OF PROPERTIES REGISTERED UNDER § 4-5 {"REGISTRATION REQUIRED"}

12 § ~~4-14~~ 4-16. [§ 4-13.] Enforcement by citation.

13 (a) *In general.*

14 In addition to any other civil or criminal remedy or enforcement procedure, this subtitle
15 may be enforced by issuance of an environmental citation as authorized by City Code
16 Article 1, Subtitle 40 {"Environmental Control Board"}.

17 (b) *Process not exclusive.*

18 The issuance of an environmental citation to enforce this subtitle does not preclude
19 pursuing any other civil or criminal remedy or enforcement action authorized by law.

20 § ~~4-15~~ 4-17. [§ 4-14.] Penalties.

21 (a) *In general.*

22 Any person who violates a provision of this subtitle or of a rule, regulation, or order
23 adopted or issued under this subtitle is guilty of a misdemeanor and, on conviction, is
24 subject to a fine of not more than \$500 for each offense.

25 (b) [~~Each day a separate offense~~] ~~CALCULATING OFFENSES.~~

26 (1) ~~IN GENERAL.~~

27 EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, EACH [Each] day that a

29 (2) ~~POSTING REQUIREMENT.~~

30 EACH WEEK THAT A VIOLATION OF § 4-12 {"VACANT STRUCTURE: POSTING
31 REQUIREMENT"} OF THIS SUBTITLE CONTINUES IS A SEPARATE OFFENSE.

1 (b) Each day a separate offense.

2 Each day that a violation continues is a separate offense.

3 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance
4 are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior
5 Ordinance.

6 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 180th
7 day after the date it is enacted.
