The Baltimore City Health Department (BCHD) is pleased to have the opportunity to review Council Bill #20-0239R, entitled, "Informational Hearing - Responding to Mental Health Crises." The purpose of this bill is to call on several City agencies and mental health advocates "to investigate how behavioral and mental health crises are handled, identify gaps, and develop the best path forward for addressing and de-escalating crises."

BCHD is a strong proponent of a "health in all policies" approach, and addressing mental health crises should be no different. Regarding the specifics of how such events should be handled, however, BCHD defers to Behavioral Health System Baltimore (BHSB), the designated local authority on behavioral and mental health. In deferring to BHSB, BCHD has **no objections** to Council Bill #20-0239R.
