12 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That 13 Sheet 11of the Zoning District Map is amended by changing from the I-1 Zoning District to the 14 OIC Zoning District the property known as 4207-4209 Menlo Drive, as outlined in red on the 15 plat accompanying this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That as evidence of the authenticity of the 16 17 accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning 18 Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat; 19 and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the 20 Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals, the Planning Commission, the Commissioner of 21 Housing and Community Development, the Supervisor of Assessments for Baltimore City, and 22 23 the Zoning Administrator.

24 **SECTION 3.** AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day 25 after the date it is enacted.
