The Department of Planning is in receipt of City Council Bill #20-0586, which is for the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell, at either public or private sale, all its interest in certain property known as the former Lake Clifton Gate House, located at 2803 Saint Lo Drive (Block 4199, Lot 008) and no longer needed for public use; and providing for a special effective date.

The Department of Planning recommends approval of City Council Bill #20-0586. This property is known as the Valve House as it formerly contained equipment related to the water system dating back to the lake in the Park. It has been vacant for many years and is adjoining the former Lake Clifton High School. The vacant valve house is in very poor condition and the City has no use for it. The property does have tremendous potential as an entry gateway to a redeveloped former Lake Clifton High School site, therefore we recommend the two parcels be sold together.
