## AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

## Rezoning - 555 Dundalk Avenue and Block 6694, Lot 142

- FOR the purpose of changing the zoning for the properties known as 555 Dundalk Avenue (Block
  6694, Lot 141) and Block 6694, Lot 142, as outlined in blue on the accompanying <u>amended</u>
- 4 plat, from the I-1 Zoning District to the <del>IMU-2</del> <u>C-4</u> Zoning District; and providing for a
- 5 special effective date.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That

- 13 Sheets 59 and 60 of the Zoning District Map are amended by changing from the I-1 Zoning
- 14 District to the IMU-2 C-4 Zoning District the properties known as 555 Dundalk Avenue (Block
- 15 6694, Lot 141) and Block 6694, Lot 142, as outlined in blue on the <u>amended</u> plat accompanying
- 16 this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That as evidence of the authenticity of the 17 18 accompanying amended plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City 19 Council shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign 20 the plat; and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat 21 22 to the Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals, the Planning Commission, the Commissioner of Housing and Community Development, the Supervisor of Assessments for Baltimore City, and 23 24 the Zoning Administrator.
