**AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING**

**Commission on Sustainability – Officers**

FOR the purpose of allowing the appointment of co-chairs for the Commission on Sustainability.

BY repealing and reordaining, with amendments

Article 5 - Finance, Property, and Procurement  
Section(s) 34-2(b)  
Baltimore City Code  
(Edition 2000)

**SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

**Baltimore City Code**

**Article 5. Finance, Property, and Procurement**

**Subtitle 34. Commission on Sustainability**

**§ 34-2. Terms; Chair OR CO-CHAIRS.**

...  
(b) *Commission Chair OR CO-CHAIRS.*

The Mayor shall appoint one member as Chair of the Commission OR MAY APPOINT TWO MEMBERS AS CO-CHAIRS OF THE COMMISSION.

**SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.

**SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day after the date it is enacted.
