Position: Does Not Oppose

The Department of Finance is herein reporting on City Council Bill 20-0576, Sale of Property-Former Beds of a 13-Foot Alley and a 20-Foot Alley, the purpose of which is to authorize the Mayor and City Council to sell certain parcels of land at either public or private sale.

Background

This legislation will authorize the Mayor and City Council to sell a parcel of land known as the former beds of a thirteen-foot and twenty-foot alley, bounded by East Biddle and North Washington Street. These alleys are located near the Hoen Lithograph Building and Israel Baptist Church.

Fiscal Impact

The Department of Finance cannot provide an estimate of possible revenue from the sale at this time because the Department of Transportation has not yet completed an appraisal. However, the Department of Transportation generally seeks fair market value for sales of property.

Conclusion

This legislation will enable the Mayor and City Council to sell a certain parcel for development that is no longer needed for public use. At this point in time, an appraisal has not been completed, but the Department of Transportation intends to seek fair market value for the parcels.

For the reasons stated above, the Department of Finance does not oppose City Council Bill 20-0576.
