Major Issues Discussed

- 5. Representatives for other City agencies confirmed the recommendations in the written reports. Chairman Reisinger noted that the Fire Department had no objection to the bill.
- 6. Nicole Lacoste Folks discussed the considerations and findings required for approval. Victor Tervala confirmed that the facts presented would satisfy the legal requirements.
