**Re: City Council Bill 20-0581 Sale of Property - A Portion of South Boston Street,
Extending from South Haven Street**

The Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) has reviewed City Council Bill 20-0581 for the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell, at either public or private sale, all its interest in a certain parcel of land known as a variable width portion of Boston Street extending from South Haven Street, Westerly 723.60 feet, more or less, and no longer needed for public use; and providing for a special effective date.

This legislation was introduced at the request of the Department of Transportation. If enacted, City Council Bill 20-0581 would sell, at either public or private sale, a portion of South Boston Street that is no longer needed for public use.

This is a companion piece of legislation to City Council Bill 20-0580 which will allow for the closing of a portion of South Boston Street extending from South Haven Street in support of a private mixed-use development project.

DHCD does not object to the passage of City Council Bill 20-0581.
