The Department of Planning is in receipt of City Council Bill #20-0582, which is for the purpose of condemning and closing a variable width portion of Boston Street, from a point 723.60 feet Westerly from the west side of South Haven Street and extending Westerly 524 feet, more or less to the east side of South Conkling Street, 60 feet wide, as shown on Plat 349-A-44A in the Office of the Department of Transportation; and providing for a special effective date.

The Department of Planning recommends approval of City Council Bill #20-0582, which in conjunction with the street closure proposed in CCB #20-0580, will support a large mixed-use redevelopment project in this block. The excess width on the north side of the 3800-Block of Boston Street is no longer needed for a public purpose, and so may be closed and sold to be assembled into the adjacent development project.
