INTRODUCTION – Rezoning - 407 Benninghaus Road

<u>PURPOSE/PLANS</u> – For the purpose of changing the zoning for the property known as 407 Benninghaus Road (Block 5014C, Lot 004A), as outlined in red on the accompanying plat, from the R-3 Zoning District to the OR-1 Zoning District.

<u>COMMENTS</u> – Council Bill 20-0567 looks to rezone 407 Benninghaus Road from the R-3 Zoning District to the OR-1 Zoning District. Per the TransForm Baltimore Zoning Code, the R-3 Zoning District is described as having detached residential dwellings with limited commercial uses. OR-1 Zoning Districts are classified as office-residential with building height limits set at approximately 40 feet. The property is located roughly one block west of York Road, behind several commercial establishments.
