- 5. Livhu Ndou explained the unfavorable recommendation on the bill from the Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals.

- 7. Christopher DeCarlo discussed the existing use of the subject property and the facts that support rezoning the property.
- 8. An attorney representing the adjoining property owner testified in opposition to the rezoning.
- 9. The committee voted to approve the findings of fact.
- 10. The committee voted to recommend the bill favorably.
