Re: City Council Bill 20-0602 - Sale of Property- 4701 Greenspring Avenue aka Former Dr. Roland Patterson School #082

Dear President and City Council Members:

The Law Department has reviewed City Council Bill 20-0602 for form and legal sufficiency. The bill would allow the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell its interest in the property known as 4701 Greenspring Avenue aka Former Dr. Roland Patterson School #082 and no longer needed for public use. The bill also provides for a special effective date.

Article V, Section 5(b) of the Baltimore City Charter grants the Department of Real Estate in the Comptroller's Office the power to arrange for the disposition of any building or parcel of land no longer needed by the City for public use, if that sale is approved by the Board of Estimates. Assuming the agency reports reveal that the property is no longer needed for public use, this is the appropriate ordinance to authorize disposition of the subject property. Therefore, the Law approves the bill for form and legal sufficiency.
