<u>INTRODUCTION</u> – City Streets - Opening - 10-Foot Alley

<u>PURPOSE/PLANS</u> – For the purpose of condemning and opening a 10-foot alley bounded by Etting Street, a variable width alley, West Lafayette Avenue, and West Lanvale Street, as shown on Plat 326-A-32 in the Office of the Department of Transportation; and providing for a special effective date.
