Position: Does Not Oppose

The Department of Finance is herein report on City Council Bill #20-0633, introduced for the purpose of naming the field house located at 3000 East Madison Street to be the Rocky Brown Field House.

Background

Renovations on the Bocek Recreation Center began in 2019 and the Center opened in summer 2020. This legislation proposes renaming the facility after Rocky Brown, a local resident and President of the Bocek/Madison East End Community Association.

Fiscal Impact

The Department of Finance anticipates that this legislation will have a minimal fiscal impact for the City. Anticipated costs would be solely for new signage with the new name of the facility. The average cost for a metal sign, produced by the Department of Transportation, is \$252, which includes the sign materials, design, hardware, and installation.

Conclusion

The Department of Finance anticipates that this legislation will be of minimal cost to the City.

For the reasons stated above, the Department of Finance does not oppose City Council Bill 20-0633.
