Major Issues Discussed

- 1. Chairman Stokes began the hearing but due to technical issues Vice Chairman Burnett served as chairman for today's hearing.
- 2. Caylin Young, gave opening remarks and informed the attendees that the Commission was created as a result of Council Bill 17-0063 Citizens Advisory Commission for Public Safety. Some additional highlights of his conversation were:
 - Talked about the selection process pertaining to the nominees
 - a. Over eighty (80) applicants
 - b. Commission will have a member from each Police District
 - c. Talked about some of the criteria need for other nominees
 - d. Filling the requirements of the Ordinance is important
 - e. Process was selecting nominees is/was thorough and about the importance of making sure to select the right nominees.
- 3. Committee member Clarke stated, "When the Consent Decree ends this is the group who will be in place to oversee the police and citizens. And, this is only the first round of nominees; twenty-three members in total will be appointed to the Commission."
- 4. Chairman Burnett asked all nominees to talk about their background, interest in the position and about his/her vision for the Commission.
- 5. Councilman Stokes stated, "Young people also need to be nominated to serve on the Commission; they are the ones who interacts mostly with the police."
- 6. Ms. Randolph is one of ten (10) nominees who came before the committee today. She talked about her background and/or experiences. Some highlights of same were:
 - o Will serve as a member from the Western Police District
 - o Is a city resident
 - Originally from New Jersey
 - o Advanced degree: Law
 - Background:
 - Dealing with Human Rights Issues
 - Policy advisement
 - Will take her background and experiences to the Commission
 - While serving on Commission:
 - Would like to work with law enforcement abuses
